  - A. **25-01644 – 18 Gay Street – 15-9-189:** Placing a thin wooden sign on the exterior border of the front main window that is 15” x 60”. The sign will be mounted by reinforced French cleats & screws.
- VIII. New Business
  - A. **25-01903 – 231-233 Bridge Street - 15-9-142:** Removing the 1st and 2nd floor wood additions which are in very poor condition. The building has been altered significantly since it was built in 1842. The intention is to recreate the "double line of piazzas" (porches) that were added in 1871, extending the entire length of the building. The triple-arched window on the 2nd floor with classical detailing, informed the new facade design.
  - B. **26-00001 – 26 Main Street - 15-9-339:** Project consists of updating existing storefront signage for a new retail storefront. Improvements include installing a hanging blade sign that will be brown and cream and read “Great Scott Vintage” with the fish lamp logo. Improvements also include updating the existing window decal to say “Great Scott Vintage” and “Clothing. Homewares. Gifts.” in a gold leaf design.
