Meeting Called to order: The meeting was called to order by Ms. Hunter at 6:30 pm after declaring the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Minutes: Ed Lantzy made a motion to approve the minutes from the October 2025 meeting. seconded by Allison Peffle. Approved.

Visitors – Public Comment: Judy Wolstenholm presented a proposal for an Indoor Bocce Ball court. The equipment needed would be portable and the size could be adjustable according to available room space. Set up time (after initial build) would be 5-10 minutes. The frame would be either 6x6 or 4x4 beams and a weighted indoor rubber ball would be used. Judy offered to donate the first set (cost \$20-\$70). Estimate for the project would be less than \$800. The activity would be accessible for all abilities. Suggested cost to participate would be \$5 per session.
